

## ***2009 Show Ticket Information***

Please read the following information very carefully since some things may have changed or may not have been finalized since we may have spoken with you at the studio:

**PLEASE NOTE: It is our policy that all accounts must be paid in full before show tickets may be purchased.**

Tickets will go on sale, at the studio, on Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup> beginning at 2:00pm for the Saturday 2:00pm and 6:00pm shows and at 4:00pm for the Sunday 1:00pm and 5:00pm shows. The cost is \$7.00 for children 12 and under and \$10.00 for adults. Every individual must have their own ticket. Infants will be allowed in adult arms or in carriages at available space within the theater.

If you do not know which show your child is in, please check the bulletin board at the studio. A letter "P" indicates the dancer's primary show...the show you should plan to attend, along with family and friends. By identifying a primary show we are able to distribute seating more evenly across the four performances. You are still free to purchase tickets to the other shows if you should choose to do so. We will also make recommendations for seating based upon your child's position on stage during their performance.

Each year we provide sequential numbers to maintain the order in which people have arrived to purchase tickets. We will begin distributing these numbers 15 minutes prior to the show time scheduled sale. If you arrive early to purchase a ticket please remember that we will not sell any tickets until the designated sales times indicated above. We will page you when it is time for you to buy your tickets.

This year we will once again implement a "Will Call" system for ticket purchases. If you don't want to stand in line you may reserve your tickets with a check or credit card payment at any time beginning Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm We will record the date and time of your order, file your request and assign the best seats available after initial sales are completed on May 16<sup>th</sup>.

All ticket sales are reserved seating. There is no limit to the number of tickets you may purchase; however, you may only buy tickets for your own family and friends and we ask that you be reasonable in your request. In the past there have been instances where some student families have purchased tickets for others who had not paid their account in full. Such behavior is a clear violation of our policy, is terribly inappropriate and we are aware when it occurs. There will not be any refund for unwanted tickets however we will try to help you sell any excess tickets.

Again, we would like to remind you...**YOU MAY NOT PURCHASE TICKETS UNTIL YOUR ACCOUNT IS PAID IN FULL!!!** If you have any questions please feel free to call the studio or you may send an email to [broadwayboundpac@comcast.net](mailto:broadwayboundpac@comcast.net) .
