It's Showtime!

...all you need to know about the annual recital!



There is a tremendous amount of time and effort that goes into producing the annual performance. There was once a time that we provided individual printed packets for students to bring home with many pages of information. Sometimes the information got home...sometimes it didn't and the cost of producing the printed material was significant. Times...and technology...have changed. Much of the information you will need is attached or included with this newsletter. As additional information becomes available, we will email it to you. All of the information will also be posted on the Broadway Bound Website [\(web site for information\)](#).

We will have four shows this year, two on Saturday June 25th at 12:00pm and 5:00pm and two on Sunday, June 26th at 11:00pm and 4:00pm. The show assignments are completed, and they are posted at the studio. We have also posted the dances that will be in each show and the rehearsal schedule. Your primary resource for show information will be via our email distribution list. Information will also be available on the website on the "It's Showtime" page. The bulletin board, at the studio, is also used to update you on show information. Please get in the habit of checking the board. We have scheduled set-up and Competition Team Rehearsals at the Amato Theater at the Boys and Girls Club in Milford for Friday, June 24th. All other performers will rehearse before their shows on Saturday, June 25th and Sunday, June 26th.

Again, there will be a mandatory dress rehearsal, at the theater, before each show.

Recital tickets go on sale May 21st

Show tickets will be going on sale beginning Saturday, May 21st at 3:00pm. Ticket sales will be **on-line via the internet**. You will be able to purchase tickets from the comfort of your home, day or night, using your computer, iPad or whatever. If you inquire at the desk, we can advise you as to which side of the theater may be best viewing for your dancer. You will be able to select the seats you want and receive a printout of your tickets and a confirmation of the sale. Tickets may only be purchased with a credit or debit card. Tickets in the Orchestra (lower theater) are \$20.00 and the Mezzanine (Upper theater) are \$18.00.

AND REMEMBER...all accounts must be paid in full before you purchase tickets. We will be sending a final statement to everyone with a balance. Please do not assume the statement is wrong and ignore it. If you have a balance you believe is incorrect please contact us immediately, so we may resolve it. Please make sure your email address is correct in our database.

For security reasons this information is NOT available on-line. **ALSO:** Be sure your name is spelled correctly. This is the spelling we have in our database and it is the same spelling we will use for the show program.

Tights, shoes and leotard requirements

A list of requirements for tights or socks and shoes for the recital is posted on the studio bulletin board. You can also find it on the [Showtime page](#) on the website. The list includes the type and color of the required shoes. Please be sure to check to see what you will need. **AND REMEMBER...tights are NOT INCLUDED with costumes. You will need to provide appropriate tights for your performer.**

We also ask that all students be dressed in the appropriate shoes. Our last shoe order for the year will be made in early June. If you do not have the right color shoes you are not required to purchase new ones however any new shoes that are purchased should be the proper color. **AND REMEMBER the backstage changing area is not particularly enclosed. To prevent embarrassment, any female student with a costume change in the show (NOT Kidz classes) is required to wear a neutral colored leotard under**

their costume.



Leotards may be purchased at any retail store or they may be ordered from Broadway Bound at a cost of \$18.00.
