Show Details

The 21st annual recital will be held at the Amato Theater at the Boys and Girls Club of Souhegan Valley, in Milford on June 26th and 27th. Directions to the theater are available on the Broadway Bound website www.broadwaybondpac.com, the Amato Theater website <http://www.amatocenter.org> or through Google Maps.

There will be four shows...Saturday at 10:30am and 2:30pm and Sunday at 1:00pm and 4:00pm. Multiple performances allow us to keep the shows relatively short, comply with COVID protocols, and provide ample audience space to accommodate all families without limiting ticket purchases. Your child may be required to be in more than one show. **To find out what show or shows your child may be in please check the bulletin board in the studio lobby. For security reasons this information is not provided on the website.**

Tickets: The Amato Theater provides us the opportunity to offer reserved seating. Tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis and there will not be a limit on the number of tickets you may purchase. Tickets will go onsale at the studio on Sunday, June 13th. Please see the ticket information sheet for details. Orchestra seats (lower level closest to the stage) are \$18.00. Mezzanine seats (upper level) are \$16.00. Infants (under the age of one) are free but they must be held in the arms of an adult. If you wish to provide a seat for them you must purchase a ticket. Anyone over the age of one must have their own ticket. No exceptions. Dancers in the show do not need a ticket. You may still be able to purchase tickets at the rehearsal on Friday, June 25th and at the door prior to each show **IF SEATS ARE AVAILABLE**. Special Needs student families and Handicaped Seating require special arrangements. Please check at the desk for instructions.

PLEASE NOTE: All accounts must be paid in full before you purchase your tickets.

With the continued growth of the studio, as well as the constraints placed upon us by COVID protocols, we encourage you to purchase your tickets early. Don't be disappointed! Again...first come...first served. **You are not guaranteed a seat.**

Rehearsals: There will be a mandatory dress rehearsal for each show at the Amato Theater prior to each performance. The rehearsal schedule is posted on the website and on the studio bulletin board. Please be prompt. You must be ready to dance at your scheduled time.

- Our youngest students, Talented Twos, Babies, Preschool and Kindergarten, will rehearse last. They should go backstage to the "green room" to wait to be called. They should sit in their designated location. This is exactly what they will do at the show as well.
- Performers may leave rehearsal immediately after they are finished. However, all performers must be backstage thirty minutes before their show begins.
- For all performers, other than Kidz Kombo (the little kids), we ask that when you arrive at the theater please take a seat in the auditorium in full costume and shoes. We will call you to the stage when your class is ready to rehearse. For the show you will assemble in the "green room" backstage.

Show Rules: On the website you will find the rules for the show. These rules have been implemented because we have experienced situations that require them. Each rule has a story behind it. We don't want to have rules but, unfortunately, we need them. Please read them carefully. We would appreciate your full cooperation.

Show Video: This year the show will once again be professionally recorded by Goodheart Media. We believe their previous years videos have been very good and we have contracted with them again. All orders placed prior to the recital are \$35.00 each and orders placed thereafter are \$40.00. DVDs will be shipped to the studio and distributed when they are received. This is a priceless treasure to have. Order forms and further details are available at the studio and on the website.

Picture Day: This year we have once again contracted with Donner Photographic, Inc. for our student portraits. Our pictures will be taken at the studio on Saturday, June 5th and Sunday, June 6th. In addition to individual pictures, a group picture will be taken of each class. You may also request to have sibling photos and photos with friends. In deference to others in your class please show up for the group pictures even if you do not choose to purchase any pictures. No payment is required at Picture Day.
